Distances: The 5000 Run is 5K. The Duathlon is a 5K run, 30K bike and a 2.5K run.

Course: The old Knights Ferry Duathlon course – Run is a paved loop, the bike is a paved out-and-back with rolling hills.

Entry Fee: Duathlon - \$45.00 per person pre-registered, \$50.00 day of. Duathlon Relay (1 runner & 1 biker) \$85 per relay team pre-registered, \$95 day of. 5K Run - \$30.00 per person pre-registered, \$35.00 day of. Includes T-shirt, refreshments, beer and great prizes. 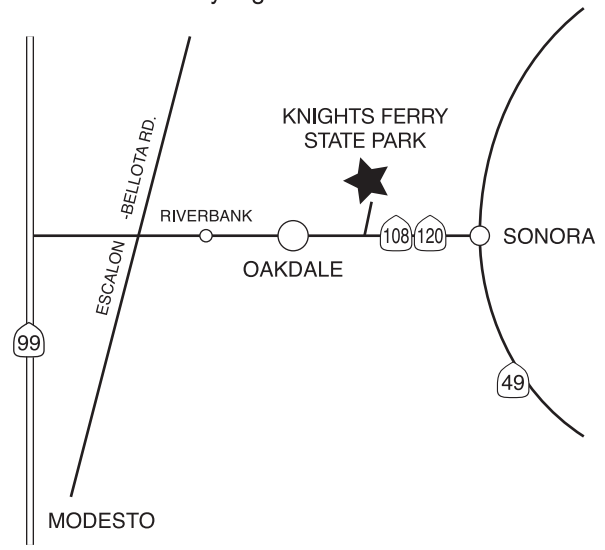
Awards: Medals three deep in ten year age groups through 70+. Great trophies to overall winners.
